


Directions to the Lincoln National Weather Service Office



The NWS office is located on Highway 10 on the east side of Lincoln, just east of the Lincoln Christian College. Look for the radar tower on the north side of the road.

From the southwest (via Springfield): Get off I-55 at exit 123 (business 55). Follow this road to 5th Street (first stoplight) and turn east. Follow 5th St. around the curve (becomes Logan St.) and turn right at the second stoplight (Highway 10/121, Keokuk St.). Go about ¼ mile to where Highways 10 and 121 split apart, and turn left on Highway 10. Go past Lincoln Christian College, and the office will be on the left.

From the northwest (via Peoria): At the intersection of I-155 and I-55, go south on I-55 for 1 mile. Get off at exit 126 (Highway 10/121). Turn left (east) at the bottom of the ramp. Follow Highway 10/121 all the way through town. When they split apart on the east side, turn left on Highway 10. Go past Lincoln Christian College, and the office will be on the left.

From the northeast (via Bloomington): Get off I-55 at exit 133 (business 55). Turn left. At 1400th Ave., turn left. Follow this road about 1.5 miles (goes along the east side of Logan County Airport) to Highway 10 (“T” intersection) and turn right. The office is about ¼ mile on the right.

From the southeast (via Decatur): Take Highway 121 northwest through Mount Pulaski. On the southeast side of Lincoln, at the intersection with highway 10, turn right. Go past Lincoln Christian College, and the office will be on the left.
